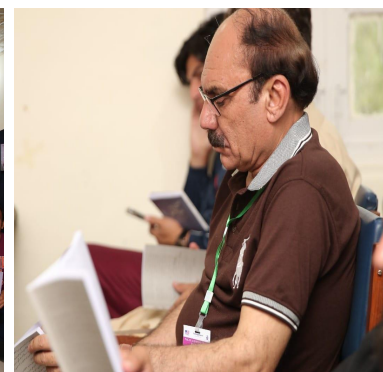

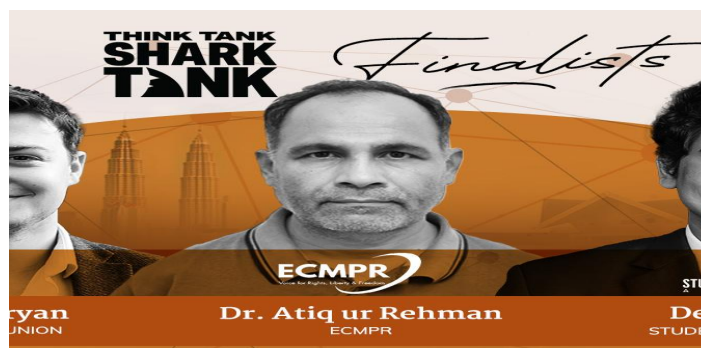


Consultative Meeting of ECMPR Team with Management of Karakoram University Pakistan
